



## Out-of-Pocket Expenses - Upper School

The charges below are an estimate of expenses a family may have in addition to the standard tuition. Many of these expenses are optional. Charges billed to a student's account are indicated with an asterisk. (\*)

There may be additional charges throughout the school year depending on the child's interests and his or her participation with various athletic teams, clubs, and extracurricular programs.

Books and supplies are available through MBS Direct, an online buying site. MBS Direct provides a convenient and cost-effective solution for textbook purchases and buybacks.

Students new to grades 9-12 must purchase a laptop computer at the current cost of \$1,650. All laptops are replaced once every four years for those students in grades 5-12. A lease program is available for students receiving need-based tuition assistance. Families who may need financial assistance with some of the optional program charges below should contact the division head for more information.
